

A RESOLUTION

AIMING TO REDUCE THE CITY OF SANTA FE'S "CARBON FOOTPRINT."

WHEREAS, the City of Santa Fe is proud of its cultural and historical significance among North American communities; and

WHEREAS, the City of Santa Fe has passed Resolution No. 2006-55 supporting the efforts to reduce greenhouse gas emissions by 2030; and

WHEREAS, the City of Santa Fe has passed Resolution No. 2006-127 which called for a City government-wide effort to reduce the energy and telecommunication needs; and

WHEREAS, the City of Santa Fe has hired staff to provide, and have provided, savings on City government energy consumption; and

WHEREAS, the City of Santa Fe has supported the efforts of City staff, via a "green team" approach, to reduce the City government energy use and to improve the effect that City government activity has on the environment; and

WHEREAS, global and national events make it imperative that local governments and the communities that they serve should take proactive and positive steps to reduce the impact (or,

1 "carbon footprint") on the environment.

2 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE**
3 **CITY OF SANTA FE** that the Governing Body hereby declares that it intends, as an overarching
4 and achievable goal, to reduce the carbon footprint of City government on the environment by a
5 total of twenty percent (20%) within five years.


6 **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** that the Governing Body hereby directs City staff to
7 estimate or calculate the "carbon footprint" that City government currently has and after such
8 calculation/estimation is made, to provide options, remedies, alternatives and solutions for how
9 City government can achieve its goal.

10 **PASSED, APPROVED and ADOPTED this 9th day of July, 2008.**


