

A RESOLUTION

**DIRECTING STAFF TO RESEARCH THE POSSIBILITY OF A CARSHARING  
PROGRAM TO BE LOCATED AT THE RAILYARD.**

**WHEREAS,** carsharing is a model of car rental where people rent cars for short periods  
of time, often by the hour; and

**WHEREAS,** there are more than six hundred cities in the world where people can  
carshare; and

**WHEREAS,** carsharing complements public transportation, bicycles and walking; and

**WHEREAS,** a carsharing program may be run by a commercial business, a public  
agency, a private-public partnership, cooperative, or ad hoc group; and

**WHEREAS,** carsharing may be a viable and convenient service for those riding the  
Railrunner to the Santa Fe Railyard by getting them to their final destination in Santa Fe; and

**WHEREAS,** a carsharing program with high energy efficient vehicles would further  
promote the City of Santa Fe's green principles.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE**


1 CITY OF SANTA FE that that staff is directed to research and report to the Governing Body


