

10 A RESOLUTION

11 REVISING FEES RELATING TO FIRE PREVENTION AND PROTECTION.

13 WHEREAS, Chapter 12 SFCC 1987 provides regulations regarding fire prevention and
14 protection within the city of Santa Fe; and

15 WHEREAS, the city experiences costs related to fire prevention and protection within
16 the city of Santa Fe for inspections, plan review and similar services; and

17 WHEREAS, Section 12-2.2 SFCC 1987 authorizes the governing body to adopt, by
18 resolution, fees relating to fire prevention and protection; and

19 WHEREAS, the governing body last revised the fees relating to fire prevention and
20 protection in 2004 (Resolution No. 2004-93).

21 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE
22 CITY OF SANTA FE that:

23 Section 1. The city of Santa Fe revises the schedule of fees as set forth in the
24 attached Exhibit A.


25 Section 2. Staff is directed to periodically review and propose an update to the fees,

1 penalties and fines and other charges established in this resolution.

2 **Section 3.** This resolution shall supersede any prior fee schedules established by the
3 city.


4 **Section 4.** All additional revenue collected by the increase in fees shall be dedicated



1 **EXHIBIT A**

2 **FEEs RELATING TO FIRE PREVENTION AND PROTECTION**

3 **A. INSPECTION FEES**

4 (1) Prior to inspections performed for issuance of certificate of occupancies
5 or special use permit required for (a) business registrations as set forth in Section 18-2.4
6 SFCC 1987, (b) business licenses as set forth elsewhere in Section 18-2 of SFCC or (c)
7 such other purposes as described elsewhere in the city code, the following fees shall be
8 collected. Non-profit organizations and short term rentals are exempt from this fee.

9 Home occupancy businesses	\$25
10 Itinerant Vendors	\$25
11 Businesses of 3,000 square feet or less	\$75
12 Businesses of 3,001 to 6,000 square feet	\$150
13 Businesses of 6,001 to 9,000 square feet	\$200
14 Businesses of 9,001 to 12,000 square feet	\$250
15 Businesses of more than 12,001 square feet	\$300
16 Tents*	\$50
17 Canopies* or group of canopies, with an area up to 400 square feet	No permit fee
18 Canopies or group of canopies with an area exceeding 400 square feet	\$50
19 Fire permits	\$10

20 *as defined in the fire code of the city of Santa Fe as adopted in Section 12-2.1 SFCC

22 (2) Prior to required annual fire inspections for certain occupancies in
23 accordance with Section 12-2.3.SFCC 1987, the following fees shall be collected. The fee
24 shall be an annual fee. Non-profit organizations are exempt from this fee.

25 Businesses of 1,500 square feet or less	\$30

1	Businesses of 1,501 to 3,000 square feet	\$50
2	Businesses of 3,001 to 6,000 square feet	\$100
3	Businesses of 6,001 to 9,000 square feet	\$150
4	Businesses of more than 9,001 square feet	\$200

5 (3) If an inspection performed in accordance with paragraphs (1) or (2)
6 above results in the need for one or more re-inspections, a \$50 re-inspection fee shall be
7 collected for each re-inspection.

8 **B. PLAN REVIEW FEES**

9 The following fees shall be collected for each fire suppression system plan review which
10 is required for compliance with the fire code of the city of Santa Fe.

11	Residential automatic fire sprinkler system plans	\$50
12	Commercial automatic fire sprinkler system plans	\$150
13	Commercial automatic fire sprinkler system modification plans	\$50
14	Commercial fire alarm system plans	\$50
15	Commercial hood fire suppression system plans	\$50
