

A RESOLUTION

**DESIGNATING THE LAND USE SUB-COMMITTEE, A SUB-COMMITTEE OF THE
PUBLIC WORKS / CIP & LAND USE COMMITTEE.**

WHEREAS, Resolution No. 2000-59 clarified the duties of the city of Santa Fe Public
Works/CIP and Land Use Committee; and

WHEREAS, the Governing Body recognizes the need to establish a sub-committee of
the Public Works / CIP & Land Use Committee to oversee the city's land use type functions and
to make recommendations to the Governing Body regarding numerous large, critically important,
on-going land use policies and projects; and

WHEREAS, the Governing Body adopted procedures for the formation of committees,
task forces and ad hoc committees in Resolution No. 1984-56 and as set forth below.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE
CITY OF SANTA FE** that the Land Use Sub-Committee of the Public Works / CIP & Land Use
Committee is established as follows:

Section 1. NAME: The Land Use Sub-Committee is hereby established as a sub-

1 committee of the Public Works / CIP & Land Use Committee.

2 Section 2. PURPOSE: The Land Use Sub-Committee shall oversee the city's land
3 use type functions and make recommendations to the Public Works / CIP & Land Use Committee
4 regarding numerous large, critically important, on-going land use policies and projects. The
5 creation of the Land Use Sub-Committee shall not negate the responsibilities of other committees
6 otherwise established by law or action of the Governing Body to review such policies and
7 projects.

8 Section 3. RESPONSIBILITIES: The Land Use Sub-Committee shall be
9 responsible for reviewing and making recommendations to the Public Works / CIP & Land Use
10 Committee on the following:

11 (a) The development review and building permit processes including, but not limited
12 to, implementing the recommendations from the Building Permit and Development Review Task
13 Force presented to the Governing Body in 2006 and the Moss Adams Schedule and Findings
14 regarding building permits prepared in 2006;

15 (b) Organization of the Land Use Department;

16 (c) Rewrite of Chapter 14 SFCC 1987;

17 (d) Downtown master planning;

18 (e) Review of early neighborhood notification procedures;

19 (f) Review of infill policies, the future land use map of the general plan, current
20 zoning and existing built densities; and

21 (g) Other policies and projects related to the committee's purpose.

22 Section 4. MEMBERSHIP: The Land Use Sub-Committee shall consist of two
23 members of the Public Works / CIP & Land Use Committee and one other member of the
24 Governing Body appointed by the Mayor.

25 Section 5. TERMS. The term of each member shall be six months to one year.

1 Section 6. OFFICERS: The Public Works / CIP & Land Use Committee Chair
2 person shall appoint the chair and the vice chair shall be designated by the chair of the Land Use
3 Subcommittee.

4 Section 7. MEETINGS: The Land Use Sub-Committee shall be deemed a standing
5 committee pursuant to Section 2-1.13 SFCC 1987 and shall meet at least each month or at such
6 other and additional times as may be required and shall report their findings to the Public Works /
7 CIP & Land Use Committee as a whole.
