

11 SUPPORTING THE USE OF RENEWABLE ENERGY AT THE CITY OF SANTA FE

14 WHEREAS, through Resolution No. 2006-54 the governing body endorsed the U.S.
15 Conference of Mayors Climate Protection Agreement; and

16 WHEREAS, through Resolution No. 2006-55 the governing body adopted high
17 performance energy efficient standards for city buildings; and

18 WHEREAS, the governing body supports energy efficiency for the public as well as for
19 the city of Santa Fe; and


20 WHEREAS, the draft sustainable Santa Fe plan, being finalized by the Sustainable Santa
21 Fe Commission for review and approval by the governing body, anticipates promotion of the use
22 of renewable energy; and

23 WHEREAS, the cost for renewable energy has become more comparable in price with
24 the cost for traditional sources of energy.


25 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE

3 vendors who provide renewable energy.


