11	AUTHORIZING THE CITY OF SANTA FE TO SUBMIT A RECYCLING GRANT
12	APPLICATION TO THE NEW MEXICO ENVIROMENT DEPARTMENT FOR THE
13	PURPOSE OF IMPLEMENTING A "RECYCLE SANTA FE" PROGRAM.
14	
15	WHEREAS, in accordance with the Recycling and Illegal Dumping Act (NMSA 2005,
16	§§ 74-13-1 to 74-13-20) and the Recycling, Illegal Dumping and Scrap Tire Management Rules
17	(20 NMAC 9.2) the city of Santa Fe may apply for financial assistance from the New Mexico
18	Environment Department's Recycling and Illegal Dumping Grant Fund; and
19	WHEREAS, Section 21-6.1 SFCC 1987 provides in part that the city "shall implement
20	the collection of recyclable materials from residential and nonresidential sources;" and
21	WHEREAS, the city desires to apply for a recycling grant from the New Mexico
22	Environment Department in the amount of twenty one thousand seven hundred twenty dollars
23	(\$21,720); and
24	WHEREAS, with such financial assistance, the City desires to create the "Recycle Santa
25	Fe" program; and

1	WHEREAS, the overall goals of "Recycle Santa Fe" will be to double the amount of
2	recycling the city currently pick-ups and to significantly divert recyclables from entering the
3	landfill stream; and
4	WHEREAS, the city has recently implemented weekly curbside recycling pickup from
5	residents citywide and will increase awareness by a mass media campaign paid for by the grant
6	money; and
7	WHEREAS, the city will use the grant money to inform and encourage residents and
8	nonresidents to use designated recycle centers for their motor oil, lead acid car batteries and anti-
9	freeze.
10	WHEREAS, the city will also use the grant money to purchase outdoor recycling
11	containers.
12	NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE
13	CITY OF SANTA FE that staff is authorized to submit a Recycling Grant Application to the
14	State of New Mexico Environment Department in the amount of twenty one thousand seven
15	hundred twenty dollars (\$21,720) for the "Recycle Santa Fe" program.
