11 **AUTHORIZING THE CITY OF SANTA FE TO SUBMIT A RECYCLING GRANT**
12 **APPLICATION TO THE NEW MEXICO ENVIROMENT DEPARTMENT FOR THE**
13 **PURPOSE OF IMPLEMENTING A “RECYCLE SANTA FE” PROGRAM.**

15 **WHEREAS**, in accordance with the Recycling and Illegal Dumping Act (NMSA 2005,
16 §§ 74-13-1 to 74-13-20) and the Recycling, Illegal Dumping and Scrap Tire Management Rules
17 (20 NMAC 9.2) the city of Santa Fe may apply for financial assistance from the New Mexico
18 Environment Department’s Recycling and Illegal Dumping Grant Fund; and


19 **WHEREAS**, Section 21-6.1 SFCC 1987 provides in part that the city “shall implement
20 the collection of recyclable materials from residential and nonresidential sources...;” and

21 **WHEREAS**, the city desires to apply for a recycling grant from the New Mexico
22 Environment Department in the amount of twenty one thousand seven hundred twenty dollars
23 (\$21,720); and

24 **WHEREAS**, with such financial assistance, the City desires to create the “Recycle Santa
25 Fe” program; and
