18		used to initiate	competitive sealed bid procurement for Covered Projects, which shall
19		include all con	tractual terms and conditions applicable to the procurement, as described
20		in Section 22.1	of this Purchasing Manual.
21	28.8.4	Variable Term	ns. The terms of any construction project CWA may vary in accordance
22		with the scope,	duration, cost, or other characteristics of any Covered Project and such
23		terms shall be	determined by the City in any Invitation for Bid Packet on a project-by-
24		project basis.	Provided, however, that any CWA shall incorporate terms to promote the
25		following obje	ctives:

1	(1)	Make available a ready and adequate supply of highly trained and skilled trade
2		and craft workers;
3	(2)	Accurately determine project labor costs at the outset of any construction project;
4	(3)	Establish working conditions for all construction trades and crafts for the
5		duration of the project;
6	(4)	Negotiate legally enforceable commitments with all parties to a construction
7		project to ensure labor stability and labor peace over the life of the project;
8	(5)	Facilitate increases in the number of trained and skilled local construction
9		workers through cooperative procedures and apprenticeship programs; and
10	(6)	Promotes the hiring of local subcontractors in the construction of large-scale
11		public works projects funded by gross receipts tax and general obligation bonds.
