

A RESOLUTION

**AUTHORIZING THE CITY OF SANTA FE TO SUBMIT AN ILLEGAL DUMPING  
GRANT APPLICATION TO THE NEW MEXICO ENVIROMENT DEPARTMENT FOR  
THE PURPOSE OF IMPLEMENTING A “DON’T DUMP SANTA FE” PROGRAM.**

**WHEREAS**, in accordance with the Recycling and Illegal Dumping Act (NMSA 2005,  
§§ 74-13-1 to 74-13-20) and the Recycling, Illegal Dumping and Scrap Tire Management Rules  
(20 NMAC 9.2) the city of Santa Fe may apply for financial assistance from the New Mexico  
Environment Department’s Recycling and Illegal Dumping Grant Fund; and

**WHEREAS**, the city desires to request financial assistance in the amount of twenty  
thousand dollars (\$20,000); and

**WHEREAS**, with such financial assistance from the New Mexico Environment  
Department, the City desires to create the “Don’t Dump Santa Fe” program which will encourage  
residents of our city to assist the city in preventing and abating illegal dumping; and

**WHEREAS**, on November 14, 2007 the governing body adopted Resolution No. 2007-  
100 which directed staff to propose solutions to the continued practice of improper disposal of


1 motor oil and antifreeze; and

2 **WHEREAS**, the emphasis of the “Don’t Dump Santa Fe” program will be to educate our  
3 community regarding the proper disposal of used motor oil and antifreeze; and

4 **WHEREAS**, the “Don’t Dump Santa Fe” program will serve our community by  
5 protecting our citizens from contaminates, vectors, and disease caused by improper disposal of oil  
6 and antifreeze and will ensure a healthier environment.


7 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE**  
8 **CITY OF SANTA FE** that staff is authorized to submit an Illegal Dumping Grant Application to  
9 the State of New Mexico Environment Department in the amount of twenty thousand dollars  
10 (\$20,000) for the “Don’t Dump Santa Fe” program.
