## 1 CITY OF SANTA FE, NEW MEXICO **RESOLUTION NO. 2012-7** 3 INTRODUCED BY: 4 5 Councilor Dominguez Councilor Bushee 6 7 8 9 10 A RESOLUTION 11 DIRECTING THE CITY CLERK TO LIMIT THE NUMBER OF SPECIAL DISPENSER 12 PERMITS THAT ARE ADMINISTRATIVELY APPROVED AND ISSUED AT THE SAME LOCATION, TO THREE PERMITS, PER CALENDAR YEAR; AND REQUIRING THAT 13 14 ANY REQUEST FOR A SPECIAL DISPENSER PERMIT ABOVE THREE, AT THE SAME 15 LOCATION, BE CONSIDERED BY THE GOVERNING BODY. 16 17 WHEREAS, Section 60-6A-12 NMSA 1978 regulates the use of special dispenser permits 18 by any person holding an alcohol dispenser's license; and 19 WHEREAS, in accordance with Section 4-4.5 SFCC 1987, "Any person granted a special 20 permit under the provisions of Section 60-6A-12 NMSA 1978 for use within the city shall pay in 21 advance a fee of twenty-five dollars (\$25.00) per day for each day or fraction thereof that the 22 permittee is to dispense liquor"; and 23 WHEREAS, a special dispenser's permit allows the dispensing of alcoholic beverages at a 24 function catered by the dispenser at a location other then the dispenser's place of business; and 25 WHEREAS, the Governing Body has authorized the City Clerk to administratively approve

and issue special dispenser permits on behalf of the City with the exception of special dispenser permits that are within 300 feet of a church or school, which require a waiver by the Governing Body; and

WHEREAS, neither state or local laws limit the number of times special dispenser permits are issued per location and therefore businesses that do not have liquor licenses merely obtain the services of licensed dispensers to dispense alcohol with a special dispenser permit for events that are hosted by the business; and

WHEREAS, the Governing Body finds that the unlimited use of special dispenser permits can lead to abuse because a business that regularly hosts alcohol related events should apply for its own liquor license and not rely on the services of a licensed dispenser; and

WHEREAS, the Governing Body desires to limit the number of times special dispenser permits are administratively approved and issued per location and require that the Governing Body consider any request for a special dispenser permit, above three per calendar year, at the same location.

## NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF SANTA FE that the City Clerk is directed to:

- 1. Limit the number of special dispenser permits that are administratively approved and issued at the same location, to three special dispenser permits per calendar year; and
- 2. Place on the next available City Council agenda any request for a special dispenser permit above three, at the same location, for consideration by the Governing Body.

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** that the requirements of this Resolution do not apply to the location exceptions for the sale or consumption of alcoholic beverages on City property, Article 23-6 SFCC 1987.
