11	DECLARING AN EMERGENCY AND OPPOSING LEGISLATIVE EFFORTS DURING
12	THE 2012 SESSION TO BALANCE THE STATE'S BUDGET AT THE EXPENSE OF
13	LOCAL GOVERNMENT INCLUDING ANY PROPOSAL TO REPEAL THE HOLD
14	HARMLESS PROVISION AND/OR DECREASE THE GROSS RECEIPTS TAX
15	DISTRIBUTIONS TO MUNICIPALITIES.

17	WHEREAS, the 50 <sup>th</sup> Legislature, Second Session is a 30 day session that ends on
18	February 16, 2012; and
19	WHEREAS, pursuant to state law there are currently no gross receipts taxes for food and
20	certain health care services, but to hold cities harmless, state law provides for a certain percentage
21	distribution of gross receipts tax to municipalities; and
22	WHEREAS, if the Legislature does consider repealing the food and medical hold
23	harmless provision for local governments as part of their efforts at addressing their budget the
24	City would receive significantly less in gross receipts distributions, and
25	WHEREAS, the impact to the City's general fund resulting from such a repeal is

considerable and would result in a deficit for fiscal year 2013; and

WHEREAS, said action would further have a crippling impact on future infrastructure projects, street capital projects, flood control projects, street maintenance, water improvement projects, economic development, and other uses specially authorized by the residents of the City when they authorized the imposition of additional gross receipt taxes.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF SANTA FE that the Governing Body declares that the adoption of this resolution is an emergency because the Second Session of the Legislature is a 30 day session and there is an urgent need to opposes any effort to balance the State's budget at the expense of local government including any proposal to repeal the hold harmless provision and/or decrease the gross receipts tax distributions to municipalities.

AND BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the City Clerk is directed to deliver a copy of this resolution to the Speaker of the New Mexico House of Representatives, the President Pro Tempore of the New Mexico Senate and members of the State Legislative delegation representing the Citizens of Santa Fe and the City's lobbyist.
