11	DIRECTING CITY AND PUBLIC SCHOOL STAFF TO PREPARE RECOMMENDATIONS
12	FOR THE GOVERNING BODY AND THE BOARD OF EDUCATION REGARDING
13	HOUSING ON SCHOOL PROPERTY FOR POLICE OFFICERS; AND TO DIRECT STAFF
14	TO EXAMINE AND MAKE RECOMMENDATIONS FOR THE PLACEMENT OF A
15	POLICE OFFICER ON EACH OF OUR HIGH SCHOOL CAMPUSES.

17	WHEREAS, in an effort to recruit and retain police officers, the city of Santa Fe is
18	pursuing various methods of providing affordable housing for the officers; and
19	WHEREAS, the Santa Fe school board desires to promote a safe environment on all
20	school campuses for students and staff; and
21	WHEREAS, in the past mobile homes have been located on school property in an effort
22	to provide additional school security; and
23	WHEREAS, there may be other and better opportunities to incorporate housing for
24	police officers in school campuses that will help provide a positive environment for our schools
25	and much needed housing for police officers.

2 CITY OF SANTA FE AND THE SANTA FE BOARD OF EDUCATION that: 3 1. The city manager, police chief and the director of the city's housing and 4 community development department (or their designees) shall meet with the superintendent of 5 public schools (or her designee) to initiate a discussion regarding housing for police officers on 6 school property including existing and planned elementary, middle and high schools, as well as 7 consider the possibility of placing police officers on our high school campuses, daily throughout 8 the school year. 9 2. Staff shall identify obstacles, opportunities and possible implementation steps 10 and shall prepare a recommendation to the governing body and the board of education for their 11 consideration and approval within 30 days of passage of this resolution. Staff shall ultimately 12 determine whether there is a desire to pursue this concept.
