1 CITY OF SANTA FE, NEW MEXICO 2 RESOLUTION NO. 2008 - 3 3 INTRODUCED BY: 4 5 6 7 8 9 10 A RESOLUTION 11 ESTABLISHING A RESTRICTED CASH ACCOUNT AND RELATED LIABILITY 12 ACCOUNT FOR THE SANTA FE WASTEWATER MANAGEMENT CLOSURE AND 13 POST-CLOSURE FUND TO PROVIDE FUNDS FOR FUTURE CLOSURE, POST 14 CLOSURE, PHASE I AND PHASE II, AND/OR CORRECTIVE ACTION COSTS. 15 16 WHEREAS, the City of Santa Fe through the City of Santa Fe Wastewater Management 17 Division will be operating composting facilities that will accept solid waste; and 18 WHEREAS, the post-closure care period of the composting facilities is expected to be at 19 least thirty (30) years; and 20 WHEREAS, the composting facilities will be designed and constructed to meet or 21 exceed the Solid Waste Management Regulation of the State of New Mexico; and 22 WHEREAS, the Solid Waste Management Regulations require that the owner or 23 operator shall establish financial assurance for adequate closure, post closure, Phase I or Phase II 24 assessment and/or corrective action for the facilities; and

WHEREAS, the cost for closure, post-closure, Phase I and Phase II assessment, and/or

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L	corrective action is estimated to be based on a cost summary provided by the wastewater		
2	engineer; and		
3	WHEREAS, the amount to be transferred in FY 07/08 is the full amount of \$44,000.		
4	NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THI		
5	CITY OF SANTA FE that:		
6	Section 1. The City of Santa Fe on behalf of the Santa Fe Wastewater Management		
7	Division shall establish a restricted cash account and related liability account in the Santa Fe		
8	Wastewater Management Enterprise Fund as the Closure and Post-Closure Care Fund to be used		
9	solely to fund future closure, post closure, Phase I and Phase II and/or corrective action		
10	expenditures for the Wastewater Composting Facility.		
11	Section 2. Each year, the Santa Fe Wastewater Management Division shall include		
12	as part of its annual budget submittal, an amount to be appropriated for transfer into the restricted		
13	cash account with a related liability account for the unspent appropriation. Each year the transfer		
14	will be reviewed and adjusted to reflect any increases or decreases in the original cost estimate of		
15	\$44,000 to ensure adequate funds for closure, post-closure, Phase I and Phase II assessment,		
16	and/or corrective action costs for the Santa Fe Wastewater Management Division.		
17	Section 3. Withdrawals from the restricted cash account shall only be for the		
18	purpose of closure, post-closure, Phase I and Phase II assessment, and/or corrective action as		
19	defined in the Solid Waste Management Regulations of the State of New Mexico for the Santa Fe		
20	Wastewater Management Division.		
21	Section 4. Withdrawals from the restricted cash account shall only be authorized by		
22	the Governing Body and the Secretary of the New Mexico Environmental Department upon		
23	submission of adequate proof of work performed for closure, post-closure, Phase I and Phase II		
24	assessment, and or corrective action as defined in the Solid Waste Management Regulations of		

the State of New Mexico.
