18	WHEREAS, the Governing Body desires to amend Resolution 2010-24 to require quarterly
19	reports instead of monthly reports by the City Attorney.
20	NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE
21	CITY OF SANTA FE that Resolution No. 2010-24 is amended so that the City Attorney is directed
22	to report to the Governing Body:
23	1. On a monthly basis, through electronic mail sent "Attorney-Client Privilege"; and
24	2. On at least a quarterly basis, in executive session.
25	The report shall summarize the status of pending legal matters related to litigation and non-litigation

1	matters, for which the City of Santa Fe is incurring attorney's fees and costs.
2	BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the remainder of Resolution No. 2010-24shall remain
3	in place.
