**A RESOLUTION**

**AMENDING RESOLUTION NO. 2010-24 SO THAT REQUIRED REPORTING BY THE CITY ATTORNEY TO THE GOVERNING BODY BE DONE ON A QUARTERLY BASIS.**

**WHEREAS**, on April 14, 2010, the Governing Body adopted Resolution No. 2010-24 which directed the City Attorney to report to the Governing Body, in executive session, on at least a monthly basis, to provide a summary of the status of all pending legal matters, for both litigation and non-litigation matters, for which the City of Santa Fe is incurring attorney fees and costs; and

**WHEREAS**, the Governing Body desires to amend Resolution 2010-24 to require quarterly reports instead of monthly reports by the City Attorney.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF SANTA FE** that Resolution No. 2010-24 is amended so that the City Attorney is directed to report to the Governing Body:

1. On a monthly basis, through electronic mail sent “Attorney-Client Privilege”; and
2. On at least a quarterly basis, in executive session.

The report shall summarize the status of pending legal matters related to litigation and non-litigation


1 matters, for which the City of Santa Fe is incurring attorney's fees and costs.

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


