The Governing Body of the City of Santa Fe, New Mexico met in special session on Monday, February 19, 2007 at approximately 5:10 p.m. in City Hall Council Chambers. Following the Roll Call indicated the presence of a quorum, as follows:

#### **APPROVAL OF AGENDA**

Mayor Coss noted that the agenda had been amended to add the introduction of proposed resolutions by the members of the Governing Body.

Councilor Chavez moved approval of the Agenda, as amended. Councilor Trujillo seconded the motion and it passed 8-0 by voice vote, with Councilor Bushee, Councilor Calvert, Councilor Chavez, Councilor Dominguez, Councilor Heldmeyer, Councilor Ortiz, Councilor Trujillo and Councilor Wurzburger voting for, and none against.

#### **ACTION ITEMS**

Request from the College of Santa Fe for the Following:

Pursuant to §60-6B-10 NMSA 1978, a Request for a Waiver of the 300 Foot Location Restriction to Allow the Sale of Alcoholic Beverages at the Schellaberger Tennis Center at the College of Santa Fe, 1600 St. Michaels Drive. The Requested Waiver is for the 16<sup>th</sup> Annual Red Carpet Gala to be Held on Sunday, February 25, 2007 From 5:00 p.m. to 10:00 p.m. (Yolanda Y. Vigil)

The staff report was given by Yolanda Vigil, noting that a waiver of the 300 foot location restriction is required for the sale of alcoholic beverages.

Ms. Vigil also noted that if it was the wish of the Governing Body they could grant a blanket approval of the waiver at the Schellaberger Tennis Center so that they would not have to come before the Governing Body for every request.

#### **Public Hearing**
