11	ESTABLISHING A BLUE RIBBON PANEL WHOSE SOLE PURPOSE IS TO DEVELOP	
12	AND RECOMMEND A PLAN TO END HOMELESSNESS IN SANTA FE.

14	WHEREAS, the City of Santa Fe is committed to creating and maintaining affordable	
15	housing choices for all Santa Feans; and	
16	WHEREAS, the City of Santa Fe supports a continuum of housing options for individuals	
17	and families in need, including emergency shelters, transitional housing, and permanent housing; and	
18	WHEREAS, the first Blue Ribbon Task Force on Ending Homelessness met in 2007 and	
19	developed an ambitious plan to end homelessness in Santa Fe, and	
20	WHEREAS, a number of important elements of that plan have now been completed	
21	including the Santa Fe Resource and Opportunity Center, Village Sage Apartments, the Youth Shelte	
22	Transitional Housing apartments and other projects, and	
23	WHEREAS, a number of elements of the plan have not been fully implemented; and	
24	WHEREAS, homelessness is still a problem for many people in Santa Fe.	
25	NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE	

CITY OF SANTA FE that a second blue ribbon panel is established.

- Section 1. NAME: The blue ribbon panel shall be called the Blue Ribbon Panel to End Homelessness ("Blue Ribbon Panel").
- Section 2. PURPOSE: The sole purpose of the Blue Ribbon Panel is to develop and recommend a new and updated plan to end homelessness in Santa Fe.
- Section 3. DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES: The Blue Ribbon Panel will research and develop recommendations regarding ways to end homelessness in Santa Fe. The recommendations of the Blue Ribbon Panel shall be presented to the Governing Body by December of 2012.
- Section 4. MEMBERSHIP; OFFICERS; TERM: The Mayor with the approval of the City Council shall appoint the members of the Blue Ribbon Panel. The Blue Ribbon Panel will consist of representatives from local businesses, educational institutions, social service agencies, nonprofit housing developers, veterans' organizations, law enforcement organizations, former homeless people and neighborhood representatives. The Mayor will appoint the chairperson. The chairperson shall appoint a vice-chair person. The members shall serve until they complete their duties and responsibilities as set forth above.
- Section 5. VACANCIES: Vacancies on the Blue Ribbon Panel shall be filled in the same manner as initial appointments. Members shall serve without compensation.
- Section 6. MEETINGS; DURATION: The Blue Ribbon Panel shall meet in public, at least once per month and shall conduct all meetings in accordance with the Open Meetings Act and adopted city policy and procedures.
- Section 7. STAFF LIAISON: The Office of Affordable Housing and Youth and Family Services shall serve as staff liaison to the Blue Ribbon Panel.
- **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** that the City Clerk is directed to forward a copy of this Resolution to the Santa Fe County Commission to invite the County to partner with the City in ending

1	homelessness in Santa Fe and participate in the work of the Blue Ribbon Panel to End Homelessness.
