11	DIRECTING STAFF TO AMEND CITY WATER CONSERVATION INCENTIVE
12	PROGRAM POLICIES, PROCEDURES AND THE CITY'S WEBSITE RELATING TO
13	WATER CONSERVATION DEVICE REBATES SO THAT SANGRE DE CRISTO WATER
14	CUSTOMERS ARE GIVEN OPTIONS FOR PROVIDING PROOF OF PURCHASE FOR
15	WATER CONSERVATION DEVICES THAT QUALIFY FOR A REBATE.
16	
17	WHEREAS, Section 25-11.4 SFCC 1987 authorizes the establishment of administrative
18	procedures for "minimum standards of water-use efficiency for qualifying retrofit rebate fixtures,
19	appliances and landscaping, including but not limited to toilets, waterless urinals, faucets,
20	showerheads, clothes washers, dishwashers, and weather-based irrigation controllers."; and
21	WHEREAS, the current policies and procedures for water conservation incentive rebates
22	require Sangre de Cristo Water customers to submit original receipts when applying for a rebate;
23	and
24	WHEREAS, in some cases it has become a hardship for water customers to submit
25	original receipts; and

1	WHEREAS, in an effort to assist, the Governing Body desires to amend the policies and
2	procedures for the water conservation incentive program rebates so that Sangre de Cristo water
3	customers are given options for providing proof of purchase for water conservation devices that
4	qualify for a rebate.
5	NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE
6	CITY OF SANTA FE staff is directed to amend City water conservation incentive program
7	policies, procedures and the City's website relating to water conservation device rebates so that
8	Sangre de Cristo water customers are permitted to:
9	1. Submit an original receipt that shows the purchase of a water conservation device;
10	and
11	2. Upon request from a customer for the original receipt, back from the City, water
12	conservation staff shall review and stamp the original receipt and return it back to the
13	customer.
14	BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that persons fraudulently submitting rebating information
15	will be punishable under §16-11.2 SFCC 1987.
