10 A RESOLUTION

11 AMENDING RESOLUTION NO. 2008-111 SO THAT BEGINNING THIS YEAR AND  
12 EVERY YEAR THEREAFTER, THE DATE OF THE ANNUAL RIVER FESTIVAL AND  
13 FISHING DERBY MAY BE CHANGED FROM THE FIRST SATURDAY IN JUNE TO  
14 ANOTHER DATE TO BE DETERMINED BY ANTICIPATED WATERSHED YIELD  
15 OR FOR OTHER CLIMATIC OR HYDROLOGIC REASONS.

17 WHEREAS, on December 10, 2008, the Governing Body adopted Resolution No. 2008-  
18 111 to designate the first Saturday in June, beginning in 2009 as the date for the City's annual  
19 River Festival and Fishing Derby; and

20 WHEREAS, in accordance with Resolution No. 2008-111 "Under drought or emergency  
21 management water supply conditions, as determined by the City's Sangre de Cristo Water  
22 Division the release of water to the Santa Fe River for the Fishing Derby may be suspended"; and

23 WHEREAS, on February 29, 2012, the Governing Body adopted Resolution No. 2012-  
24 12 which established administrative procedures for the Santa Fe River Target Flow Ordinance;  
25 and

1           **WHEREAS**, Section 5 of the administrative procedures addresses the Annual Fishing  
2 Derby and states that “in dry years when the anticipated watershed yield is less than 50%, or, if  
3 for other climatic or hydrologic reasons daily target flows adequate for the Fishing Derby cannot  
4 be met, the Fishing Derby will be suspended.”; and

5           **WHEREAS**, the Governing Body desires to amend Resolution No. 2008-111 and the  
6 Santa Fe River Target Flow administrative procedures so that in the event the Fishing Derby  
7 cannot be held on the first Saturday in June, it can be held on another date to be determined  
8 anticipated watershed yield or for other climatic or hydrologic reasons or it can be suspended.

9           **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE**  
10 **CITY OF SANTA FE** that:

11           **Section 1.**       Resolution No. 2008-111 is amended so that beginning this year and  
12 every year hereafter; if the annual River Festival and Fishing Derby cannot be held on the first  
13 Saturday in June due to the anticipated watershed yield being less than 50%, or, for other climatic  
14 or hydrologic reasons daily target flows adequate for the Fishing Derby cannot be met, the  
15 Fishing Derby may be suspended or the date of the Fishing Derby may be changed. The  
16 remainder of Resolution No. 2008-111 shall remain in effect.

17           **Section 2.**       Staff is directed to amend Section 5 of the Santa Fe River Target Flow  
18 administrative procedures to state:

19           **5.       Annual Fishing Derby**


20           The City of Santa Fe's Annual Fishing Derby takes place each year on the first  
21 Saturday in June. The Fishing Derby provides opportunities for children and  
22 families to join with neighbors to experience a fun and engaging day by the river,  
23 to learn about the Santa Fe River and riparian ecology, and to learn fishing skills.

25           In dry years when the anticipated watershed yield is less than 50%, or, if for




