December 6, 2012

CALL TO ORDER

A regular meeting of the City of Santa Fe Airport Advisory Board was called to order by Carolyn Cook, Chair at 4:00 p.m. on this date at the Santa Fe Municipal Airport Terminal Building, 121 Aviation Drive, Santa Fe, New Mexico.

ROLL CALL

Roll call indicated the presence of a quorum for conducting official business as follows:

APPROVAL OF AGENDA

Upon a motion by Mr. Allison, second by Mr. Talarczyk, members voted unanimously to approve the agenda as published.

APPROVAL OF NOVEMBER 1, 2012 MINUTES:

The following changes were made to the Minutes of the November 1, 2012 meeting:

Page 1, Molzen and Corbin was changed to read: "Molzen Corbin"

Page 4, 3rd paragraph from the bottom was changed to read: "Mr. Freier noted that the Master Plan for the Airport was based on pre 911-data."

Upon a motion by Mr. Talarczyk, second by Mr. Allison members voted unanimously to approve the Minutes of November 1, 2012 as amended.

AIRPORT REVIEW AND ASSOCIATED REPORTS: AIRPORT ACTIVITY REVIEW ATC TRAFFIC OPERATIONS/COUNTS REPORT AIRPORT NOISE COMPLAINTS REPORT AIRLINE ENPLANEMENT/DEPLANEMENT REPORT MONTHLY AIRPORT REVENUE REPORT

Memorandum dated December 6, 2012 to the Airport Advisory Board from Jim Montman; Aviation Division Director was distributed and reviewed. [A copy is incorporated to these Minutes as Exhibit "A".]

Mr. Montman said Lois Amador is doing a great job and has accomplished a lot in her short time at the Airport. The Airport has new disabled parking signs on the ground, new directional signs, and a couple of exterior signs, a new gate sign and the main entry sign will be reconstructed. The Eagle Scout display has been refurbished.

Ms. Amador also ensures that the leaseholders have the required insurance.

Mr. Montman noted that all the furniture in the terminal is being refinished and the control tower roof has been completed. He mentioned that the tower now has an intercom.

Mr. Montman explained that the Airport is looking into getting a video surveillance camera.

Mr. Montman reported that the Great Lakes Lease agreement was approved and needs to be signed by the CEO of Great Lakes, notarized and returned back. He said Great Lakes are up and running and they had a smooth start. The ribbon cutting for Great Lakes is scheduled for December 13th from 12:00 p.m. to 2:00 p.m. The Board Members were invited to attend.

Mr. Montman gave an update on the Taxiway A construction project noting that

Phase 1 and Phase 2 of the project are complete. The paving and painting have been done.

Mr. Montman reported that the TSA Lease is still being worked on but they should come to an agreement soon.

Mr. Montman gave an update on the grants in progress noting that everything is on track on all of the grants for the Airport.

Mr. Montman said the Wildlife Hazard Assessment report is almost ready for the final review. He mentioned that there was a bird strike on a Great Lakes aircraft since the last meeting and all the appropriate reports were done.

Mr. Montman reported that there was some movement on the Tower Lease Agreement.

Mr. Montman said they had a problem with the radar system recently because the rotary joint failed. The Airport was having problems with getting the FAA to fix it, so they contacted Senator Bingaman's office for their assistance, they got involved and the FAA eventually fixed it. The radar system is now commissioned and certified.

Mr. Montman noted that he has to make a few more changes to the Airport Certification Manual and this is a huge job.

He said the Tristate Careflight plan is moving ahead and they have been provided a draft lease agreement.

Mr. Montman said the new sweeper was delivered. He noted that it has twice the capability than the one they have now and staff will have formal training on it next week.

Mr. Montman said he still has not heard back on Mr. Allison's inquiry about the Civil Air Patrol meeting at the firefighter trailer.

Mr. Montman noted that there was a homeless individual living in an abandoned vehicle but the vehicle has been towed away.

Mr. Montman mentioned that they need to make a change to the Airport Security Program because the Airport has adjusted the size of the secured area to include Great Lakes in it. He has talked with TSA about this and they are fine with it.

Mr. Montman said he contacted Kent Freier about the Passenger Facility Charge (PFC) but he did not provide him the data/handouts. He asked Ms. Amador to follow up with him and add this as an agenda item for the next meeting.

Mr. Montman said he received great feedback from the Mayor regarding the meeting that Chair Cook and Mr. Allison had with him about his replacement when he

retires. As a result of the meeting, the City is now talking about hiring someone who has knowledge about airports and has AAA background/credentials.

Mr. Montman said there is a 3-minute film being done about the Airport that will air on the public access channel (Channel 28). Interviews with passengers and Mr. Montman have been conducted for the film. This will be aired on December 12th at 10:30 a.m. on Channel 28, which is a Comcast channel.

At the prior Board meeting, Mr. Allison talked about the lack of a remote communication outlet at the Airport. Mr. Montman said the Airport has had one all along and it does work.

Mr. Montman reported on operations noting that there were 612 more operations, when compared to this month in the prior year. However, the total-to-date operations have decreased by 3,184, when compared to the prior year.

Mr. Montman reported that there was one noise complaint for the month of November.

Mr. Montman gave an update on American Eagle's enplanement/deplanements noting that this is the third historical year, in terms of enplanements and deplanements that the Airport has ever had.

ITEMS FROM THE FLOOR

Mr. Wood noted that there is some aerial surveying presently going on.

Mr. Wood said there has been some movement with regards to back up weather equipment at the Airport. Mr. Montman noted that the back-up weather equipment has been funded and is coming.

Mr. Wood reported that the Control Tower is installing some panic buttons to alert the Fire Department in the event of an emergency. This will save several minutes in response time.

ITEMS FROM THE BOARD

Mr. Allison asked if the City sold the Skymaster Aircraft.

Mr. Montman said no; however the City will hold an auction in April and the Skymaster Aircraft will be included.
