## January 10, 2013

#### 1. CALL TO ORDER

A regular meeting of the City of Santa Fe Capital Improvements Advisory Committee was called to order by Karen Walker, Chair at 3:00 p.m. on this date in the City Councilors' Conference Room, 1<sup>st</sup> Floor, City Hall, Santa Fe, New Mexico.

### 2. ROLL CALL

Roll call indicated a quorum was present for conducting official business as follows:

#### 3. APPROVAL OF AGENDA

Mr. Shanahan moved to approve the Agenda. Ms. Van Peski seconded the motion. The motion passed unanimously by voice vote.

#### 4. APPROVAL OF MINUTES:

## • Meeting of November 8, 2012

The following changes were made to the Minutes of the November 8, 2012 meeting:

Page 3, 2<sup>nd</sup> paragraph was changed to read: "Ms. Pope said she is assuming that the **importance** of doing this project; and it being "bumped up" on the priority list is due to the proposed school."

Page 3, 3<sup>rd</sup> paragraph from the bottom was changed to read: "Mr. O'Reilly noted that the impact fees that were collected from Wal-Mart, directly adjacent..."

Ms. Van Peski moved to approve the Minutes of the November 8, 2012 meeting as amended. Mr. Lucero seconded the motion. The motion passed unanimously by voice vote.

#### 5. DISCUSSION AND ACTION ITEMS

There were no action items.

#### 6. INFORMATIONAL ITEMS

Mr. Liming referred to the Memo to the CIAC regarding the Impact Fees Collected and Waived – 2012.

#### Summary

In January 2012, the city started "Waiving" impact fees on permits for all new housing units. During 2012, the city collected a total of \$260,944 in impact fees revenue and has waived a total of \$1,018,348 in residential impact fees. The following numbers of new residential units had impact fees waived (by category):

139 Single-family units

180 Multi-family units (176 units at San Isidro Apt. Complex)

10 Guest House units

9 Residential Studios/other units

## 338 Total housing units

Mr. Liming said the \$1,018,348 does not include affordable housing. This is for residential impact fees that were waived.

Mr. Martinez asked how many of the 139 single family units/homes were affordable.

Mr. Liming said approximately 30 homes were affordable.

Mr. Lucero asked how these numbers compare to last year's numbers.

Mr. Liming said in 2011, there were 144 new housing units and 52 of those were affordable. In 2012, there were a total of 430 new single family units that received permits. Of these, 189 were affordable units.

Mr. Shanahan mentioned that Centex intends to stay in Santa Fe.

## A. Quarterly Financial Summary & Permit Report October – December 2012

[Copies of the Quarterly Financial Summary and Permit Report {Exhibit 6A} were distributed in the members' packets.]

Mr. Liming reviewed Exhibit 6A noting that the Roads Fund brought in \$42,035.00 in impact fees; the Police Fund brought in \$1,196.00; and the Fire Fund brought in \$3,394.00; for a total of \$46,625.00 for the last quarter.

Mr. Liming noted that the \$1,000,000 obligated for the Herrera Drive Extension project and \$400,000.00 for the Camino de las Crucitas project are reflected under the Roads Fund.

The cash balance as of January 1, 2013 for the Roads Fund was \$716,482.25; \$174,206.68 for the Parks Fund; \$30,405.49 for the Police Fund; and \$27,424.67 for the Fire Fund, for a total of \$984,519.09.

Mr. Liming said last night, City Council reversed their resolution to not update impact fees. The New Mexico Development Fees Act requires that the three parts of the impact fees program (i.e. land use assumptions, capital improvements plan and the actual impact fees ordinance) be updated at least every five years. However, the Act also allows for a local government to determine that, at the end of a five-year period, "no update is needed". The resolution stated that the City has made a determination that no update of land use assumptions, Capital Improvements Plan or Impact Fees is needed at this time. City Council, particularly Councilor Wurzburger, is interested in looking at the impact fees structure again.

Mr. Liming distributed copies of the *Impact Fees Annual Report (Summary of 2012 Impact Fee Activity*). He noted that this is not on the agenda but he would like the Committee to review it and possibly discuss it at the next meeting.

The Committee briefly reviewed the *Impact Fees Annual Report*. The Impact Fee Ordinance requires that annual reports be made to the Council on the effects of impact fees on new housing prices and new affordable housing, as well as any perceived inequities in implementing the plans or imposing the impact fee. This report deals with the first part of this requirement, the effect in 2005 on new housing prices and new affordable housing of the new impact fees that went into effect in 2004.

Ms. Van Peski offered some revisions to the report and Mr. Liming will make the changes.

### B. Santa Fe City Plan (New General Plan) Discussion

Mr. Liming noted that the last General Plan for the City of Santa Fe was done in 1999 and the Long Range Planning staff was tasked by Resolution to work on a new Plan. Therefore, staff is working with the Long Range Planning Committee on a new General Plan for the City.

The Committee discussed the General Plan for the future of the City of Santa Fe.
