16	WHEREAS, the City of Santa Fe ("City") has taken the lead role in the study, design and
17	construction of the Cerrillos Road Reconstruction Project ("Project"); and
18	WHEREAS, the Santa Fe Metropolitan Planning Organization through the Transportation
19	Policy Board approved the Project for placement in the FY 2013-2015 Transportation Improvement
20	Program and 2005-2030 Metropolitan Transportation Plan Future Roads Network; and
21	WHEREAS, Project Phase IIC, from Camino Carlos Rey to St. Michael's Drive/Osage
22	Avenue, is currently programmed in the New Mexico Department of Transportation's FY 2013-2015
23	Statewide Transportation Improvement Program approved by the New Mexico State Transportation
24	Commission and Federal Highway Administration for federal and state funding in the amounts of
25	\$1.5 Million, \$4.75 Million, and \$4.75 Million in FY 2013, 2014 and FY 2015, respectively, for a

total funding appropriation of \$11 Million. NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF SANTA FE that the Governing Body supports the Cerrillos Road Reconstruction Project, funded through a cooperative project agreement with the NMDOT. BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the City of Santa Fe shall accept responsibility for the project; assumes the lead role in design development and construction of the project and agrees to the terms, conditions, and certification and reporting requirements of the cooperative project agreement.
