1	adopting new legislation to establish new laws and policies is an important function of the Governing
2	Body which oftentimes requires that legislation be drafted and reviewed by committee within short
3	timeframes; and
4	WHEREAS, the Governing Body finds that there is a need to expand the Legislative
5	Services Office.
6	NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE
7	CITY OF SANTA FE that the City Manager is directed to explore the options for expanding the
8	City of Santa Fe Legislative Services Office during the Fiscal Year 2013/2014 budget process and
9	provide such options to the Finance Committee and Governing Body for consideration.
