21	Development Program as the location in which to provide the setting for the education; and
22	WHEREAS, the Santa Fe Public Schools could potentially provide a bilingual teacher,
23	teacher's aide and learning materials; and
24	WHEREAS, through the alignment of resources between the City, the County and Santa Fe
25	Public Schools, whether it be education, the facility, personnel or materials all three entities through a

1	collaborative effort have a potential for a no cost to minimal cost incursion to each entity for an
2	education environment for high needs/at risk youth.
3	NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE
4	CITY OF SANTA FE that staff is directed to work with Santa Fe County and the Santa Fe Public
5	Schools to explore the options for developing a collaboration between the City of Santa Fe, Santa Fe
6	County and the Santa Fe Public Schools to establish an education environment for high needs/at risk
7	juveniles.
