11	DIRECTING THE CITY OF SANTA FE HUMAN RESOURCES DEPARTMENT TO		
12	IMPLEMENT A VETERANS' HIRING INITIATIVE POLICY FOR THE PURPOSE OF		
13	INCREASING OPPORTUNITIES FOR VETERANS TO OBTAIN CITY EMPLOYMENT.		
14			
15	WHEREAS, the Governing Body recognizes veterans who have served and sacrificed for our		
16	Country with honor, courage and dignity; and		
17	WHEREAS, such high performance veterans could add significant value to the City of Santa Fe		
18	because they are highly skilled individuals who have benefited from training and development during		
19			
	their military service, possess a wide variety of skills and experiences, as well as the motivation for public		
20	service that will help fulfill City staffing needs; and		
21	WHEREAS, the Governing Body desires to enhance the recruitment of veterans and promote		
22	employment opportunities for veterans within the City of Santa Fe that are consistent with veterans		
23	preferences prescribed by law; and		
24	WHEREAS, the Governing Body desires to honor our veterans by establishing and		
25	implementing a Veterans' Hiring Initiative policy.		

1	NOW	, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY	
2	OF SANTA FE that the City of Santa Fe Human Resources Department (HRD) is directed to implement		
3	the following Veterans' Hiring Initiative policy in order to provide opportunities for veterans who meet or		
4	exceed the minimum qualifications for city employment to obtain City employment:		
5	1.	The HRD shall institute a Veterans' Certification Form which shall be included on every	
6		recruitment announcement. The Veterans' Certification Form will identify and certify	
7		veterans who are applying for vacancies within the City; and	
8	2.	Upon review of a veteran's application, the HRD shall verify that the veteran applicant	
9		has an honorable discharge from the military or verify that the applicant is a member of	
10		the National Guard or Reserve who has successfully completed basic training; and	
11	3.	When a veteran applicant meets or exceeds the minimum qualifications on a recruitment	
12		announcement, the applicant shall be identified by HRD on the list of eligible applicants	
13		for the department/division seeking to fill a position that the applicant is a "veteran;" and	
14	4.	The department/division seeking to fill a position shall interview the identified veterans.	
15	BE II	FURTHER RESOLVED that by adopting this Resolution the Governing Body does not:	
16	1.	Guarantee that a veteran shall be hired for the position being applied for, only that the	
17		veteran will be given an interview; and	
18	2.	Intend to supersede or modify any collective bargaining agreement that is currently in	
19		place with the City of Santa Fe.
