10 **A RESOLUTION**

11 **SUPPORTING THE SANTA FE PUBLIC SCHOOL TRANSITIONAL EDUCATION**
12 **PROGRAM (“TEP”); AUTHORIZING THE REALLOCATION OF DESIGNATED**
13 **FUNDING IN THE AMOUNT OF \$23,000 FROM CHILDREN AND YOUTH PROVIDERS**
14 **THAT HAVE DISSOLVED THEIR PROGRAMS TO THE TEP PROGRAM TO PAY FOR**
15 **SPACE RENTAL AND COORDINATION OF WRAP AROUND SERVICES FOR THE**
16 **MONTHS OF JANUARY TO MAY 2014, DURING THE IMPLEMENTATION OF THE TEP**
17 **PILOT PROGRAM.**

19 **WHEREAS,** the education of our youth, the ability of our youth to reach their potential and
20 the need to reduce the dropout rate are great concerns in the community of Santa Fe; and

21 **WHEREAS,** through the joint efforts of the Santa Fe Public Schools (SFPS) and the City of
22 Santa Fe, SFPS has established TEP – a transitional education program established with the ultimate
23 goal of reducing the dropout rate in the SFPS district; and

24 **WHEREAS,** SFPS is providing the funding sources necessary for the placement of two
25 teachers; and

1 **WHEREAS**, the City is coordinating amongst 14 of its Children & Youth providers to
2 deliver wrap around services such as support for social and emotional needs for students and their
3 families who participate in TEP; and

4 **WHEREAS**, through the implementation of TEP, more resources will be made available for
5 youth on the south side of Santa Fe and such youth will have the opportunity to meet their required
6 educational credits and ultimately graduate from high school, thus reducing the dropout rate in Santa
7 Fe; and

8 **WHEREAS**, there is a current need for the months of January to May 2014, to have available
9 funding in the amount of \$23,000 for space rental and coordination of the wrap around services that
10 are to be provided for the TEP to function; and

11 **WHEREAS**, two of the City's Children and Youth providers who were allocated funding
12 during the 2013/2014 fiscal year have since dissolved, therefore, such funding can be allocated to the
13 TEP program for space rental and coordination of wrap around services.

14 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE**
15 **CITY OF SANTA FE** that the Governing Body hereby supports the efforts of the SFPS and
16 authorizes a reallocation of designated funding in the amount of \$23,000 from designated Children
17 and Youth providers that have dissolved their programs to the TEP program to pay for space rental
18 and coordination of wrap around services for the months of January to May 2014 during the
19 implementation of the TEP pilot program.


20 **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** that the City Clerk is directed to forward a copy of this




