RELATING TO THE CITY OF SANTA FE CAMPAIGN CODE AND PUBLIC CAMPAIGN
FINANCE CODE, AMENDING SUBSECTIONS 9-2.3(I) SFCC 1987 AND 9-3.3(E) SFCC 1987
TO AMEND THE DEFINITION OF CONTRIBUTION TO INCLUDE AS A CONTRIBUTION
CERTAIN EXPENDITURES BY PERSONS OTHER THAN THE CANDIDATE OR THE
CANDIDATE'S POLITICAL COMMITTEE
BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF SANTA FE:
Section 1. Subsection 9-2.3(I) SFCC 1987 (being Ord. #1998-41, §3, as amended) is
amended to read:
I. Contribution means a loan, loan guarantee, gift, advance, pledge, contract, agreemen
or promise of money or anything of value or other obligation, whether or not these items are legally
enforceable, made directly or indirectly, to a candidate or political committee for the purpose of
influencing the outcome of a municipal election.
(1) The term "contribution" includes:
(a) The transfer of funds or anything of value between politica
