A RESOLUTION

AUTHORIZING THE CITY OF SANTA FE EMERGENCY MANAGER TO, FROM TIME TO TIME, COLLABORATE WITH A VARIETY OF COMMUNITY STAKEHOLDERS WITH AN INTEREST IN MAINTAINING, UPDATING AND MONITORING THE PROGRESS OF PROJECTS THAT ARE PLACED IN THE CITY'S *ALL-HAZARD MITIGATION PLAN*; AND AUTHORIZING THE CITY TO LOBBY THE LEGISLATURE, DURING THE 2014 LEGISLATIVE SESSION, FOR FUNDING FOR PROJECTS IN THE *ALL-HAZARD MITIGATION PLAN*.

WHEREAS, the City of Santa Fe has identified threats and hazards, both naturally occurring and human-caused, that could impact the City; and

WHEREAS, the City has dedicated numerous resources towards responding to and recovering from the potential effects of these threats and hazards; and

WHEREAS, hazard mitigation and disaster prevention efforts require attention equal to response and recovery efforts; and

WHEREAS, the City of Santa Fe, its departments and divisions and the community we serve

1 all have a role to play in mitigating the impact of these hazards and preventing these hazards from
2 becoming disasters; and

3 **WHEREAS**, the City of Santa Fe continues to update its *All-Hazard Mitigation Plan* and
4 solicit input from its partners across the community; and

5 **WHEREAS**, the *All-Hazard Mitigation Plan* has identified multiple projects to reduce the
6 impact of the primary hazards facing the City of Santa Fe; and

7 **WHEREAS**, public education, community outreach, and improvements to infrastructure are
8 the cornerstones of reducing or eliminating the impacts of hazards on our community; and


9 **WHEREAS**, a collaboration of community partners with the City of Santa Fe Fire Chief and
10 City of Santa Fe Emergency Manager will assist the City in maintaining, updating and monitoring the
11 progress of projects that are placed in the City's *All-Hazard Mitigation Plan*.

12 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE**
13 **CITY OF SANTA FE** that the Governing Body of the City of Santa Fe hereby authorizes the City of
14 Santa Fe Emergency Manager to, from time to time, collaborate with a variety of community
15 stakeholders with an interest in maintaining, updating and monitoring the progress of projects that are
16 placed in the city's *All-Hazard Mitigation Plan*.

17 **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** that the City is authorized to lobby the legislature,
18 during the 2014 legislative session, for funding to implement projects that are identified in
19 the City's *All-Hazard Mitigation Plan*.

20 **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** that the City Clerk is directed to forward a copy of
21 this resolution to the City's legislative delegation and the City's lobbyist.


