16	BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF SANTA FE:	
17	Section 1. Subsection 26-1.21 (being Ord. #2005-30(A), §51) is amended to read:	
18	26-1.21 Eligibility of SFHP Buyers	
19	A. The household income of an SFHP homebuyer shall not exceed the defined income	
20	ranges as set forth in subsection 26-1.5 except as set forth in paragraph E. below.	
21	B. The household income of an SFHP manufactured home lot buyer shall not exceed the	
22	defined income ranges as set forth in subsection 26-1.5 for a 3-person household, regardless of the	
23	household size of the SFHP buyer except as set forth in paragraph E. below.	
24	C. SFHP homebuyers and SFHP manufactured home lot buyers shall also meet	
25	additional eligibility criteria established in the administrative procedures.	

D. [A SFHP home may not be sold to a household which is smaller than the following household] Household sizes are provided as a guideline for SFHP homes in the administrative procedures unless the office of affordable housing approves in writing a smaller minimum household size[÷].

1-Bedroom	1 person household
2 Bedrooms	1-person-household

- E. An eligible buyer meeting the criteria of <u>armed services veteran</u>, emergency worker, first responder, teacher or related educational employees in Santa Fe County whose household income exceeds one hundred percent (100%) of area median income (AMI) but does not exceed one hundred twenty percent (120%) of AMI shall be eligible to purchase an SFHP unit in income range 4.
  - (1) The status of the buyer as a <u>veteran</u>, emergency worker or first responder [shall be noted on the certificate of eligibility and] shall be verified by the office of affordable housing.
  - (2) The office of affordable housing shall maintain a list of occupations that meet the requirement of emergency worker, first responder or essential worker, and the verification of veteran status pursuant to administrative procedures. [which shall include:
    - (a) Police officers;
    - (b) Nurses;
    - (c) Emergency medical technicians;
    - (d) Firefighters;
      - (e) Other health and safety workers whose services are crucial to

2	(f) Teachers and related educational employees.]
3	(3) All other eligibility requirements shall apply.
