
2 **WHEREAS**, the shortage of rental homes that are affordable and available for Santa Fe's
3 very low income renter households is a primary cause of homelessness in our community; and

4 **WHEREAS**, the City will release a Notice of Funding Availability (NOFA) in 2014 for its
5 Affordable Housing Trust Fund (AHTF) which prioritizes rental support for very low income renters,
6 many of whom are veterans, and are in danger of being homeless or transitioning out of
7 homelessness.


8 **NOW, THEREFORE BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED BY THE GOVERING BODY**

10 support efforts to build, preserve, rehabilitate and operate rental housing that is affordable for low

13 resolution to its Congressional Delegation.


