1	with other governmental entities throughout Northern New Mexico to increase the economic
2	stability of the entire region.
3	NOW, THERFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE
4	CITY OF SANTA FE that the Economic Development Division is charged to meet with other
5	governmental and nongovernmental economic development groups throughout Northern New
6	Mexico to develop strategies for how this region can best cope with the proposed workforce
7	reductions at Los Alamos National Laboratory and to work together to put such strategies into
8	effect.
