3	required to meet with the Santa Fe public schools to assess and mitigate the impacts of the		
4	develo	pment project on the Santa Fe public schools. Consideration shall be given to, but not	
5	limited	to, the following:	
6	1.	how land dedication or fees in lieu of may be authorized;	
7	2.	assessment of impacts from already approved development projects and development	
8		projects still in the review process;	
9	3.	a fair share donation of land for public schools for each new development project;	
10	4.	threshold size of developments for applicability of any requirements;	
11	5.	how any requirement fits best into the school district's procedures as well as the city	
12	1	development review process;	
13	6.	pre-submittal certification documenting communication between the developer and the	
14		school administration;	
15	7.	collection and distribution of fees;	
16	8.	preparation of all necessary Chapter 14 (land development laws) amendments for	
17		consideration by the governing body.
