1. CALL TO ORDER

A regular meeting of the City of Santa Fe Capital Improvements Advisory Committee was called to order by Neva Van Peski at 3:10 p.m. on this date in the City Councilors' Conference Room, 1st Floor, City Hall, Santa Fe, New Mexico.

4. APPROVAL OF MINUTES: January 12, 2012

The following changes were made to the Minutes of the January 12, 2012 Meeting:

Page 3, 3rd paragraph 2nd sentence was changed to read: "She said this is the most inequitable thing she has ever heard of and it continues to be so."

Page 3, last paragraph was changed to read: "Ms. Pope agreed with Ms. Van Peski and felt that it was a moot point, given that the residential impact fees are going to be suspended for two years."

A. Quarterly Financial Summary & Permit Report (January-March 2012)

[Copies of the Quarterly Financial Summary and Permit Report {Exhibit 6A} were distributed in the members' packets.]

Mr. Liming reviewed Exhibit 6A noting that there were five commercial permits. The City collected \$90,428 in the first quarter of the year.

Commissioner Shanahan sent an e-mail on April 9th to Mr. Liming requesting that the City track the residential permits that were issued and would have paid impact fees to determine what the city will be losing. He stated that there is a presumption that it will stimulate construction and the collection of construction-related gross receipts will offset the loss. At some point, someone is going to want to know whether it worked or not.

Mr. Liming said \$123,456.00 was waived in residential impact fees for this last quarter-separating out the affordable housing units.
