

MINUTES

1. Call to Order

The meeting was called to order at 3:00 pm by Vice Chair, Karleen Boggio-Montgomery. A quorum was declared by roll call.

Mr. Gabaldon moved to approve minutes as presented, second by Ms. Shaya, motion carried by unanimous voice vote.

7. <u>Staff Reports</u>

• Pro-Shop – (2012 Tournament calendar updates)

Updated Event Calendar distributed. (Exhibit A) The Friday Night No Lights Event - \$10 to hit balls has begun and will continue. We provided youth with clubs for those who did not have any. We would like to link another activity for youth and family to come in on a specified day. We had a good April and May. Promotions were covered under the Marketing report.

• Superintendent - (Golf course conditions update)

John Allen: Crew has done a fantastic job, grooming and detailing the course. 70-80% of the seed has germinated and is growing on the range. Within the next couple of weeks from 200 on we will get that portion seeded. Bunkers are being addressed; we are hauling sand to those that need it first. The new Parks Director, Ben Gurule is willing to help with trucks of sand. Greens are in good condition. Hot spots: Over the Memorial Day weekend we had an irrigation problem, #7 is coming back and we didn't lose any turf. Doing the par 3 course and spraying it with liquid fertilizer. Cutting the greens 5 days a week and rolling them 2 days a week. If there is a tournament Mr. Allen reiterated that they will be cut.

Ms. Lindell said that the clean-up has really helped the time of play. It speeded up the play.

The Vice-Chair asked if we had discussed having a siren when there is lightning. Mr. Allen said that we would be liable if we had one and if it didn't ring on time or if someone were to get hurt. The Vice-Chair asked

if we still had a sign with directions on what to do? Mr. Allen said that he will check into this and provide a status report at the next meeting.

Ms. Shaya asked about the lack of full staffing. Mr. Allen provided information as to the process they followed this year and how the lag in hiring took place. They are very close to being fully staffed.

• Marketing – (Advertising updates) - Clarissa

• Back 9 Grill – (Restaurant updates) – Mario Gonzales

May was a good month, attributed success to a lot of the tournaments. The tournament attendees are also eating lunch here. We now have two beverage carts that we fixed with this added revenue. Mr. Gonzales said that they have worked on the menu pricing.

Ms. Lindell asked about the comment from May minutes regarding the Chamber of Commerce and their concern that the contractor *could not provide the services*. Jennifer clarified that the Chamber wanted to bring food from the outside and we told them that the food needed to be ordered from the Back9 Grill. Thank you for the clarification.

Mr. Gonzales shared the same concern from tournament groups wanting to bring in donated alcohol and having Back9 Grill' staff dispense it. The board supports the policy and that it be followed, no dispensing alcohol whether gifted or donated.

• Administration – (Revenue and golf rounds summary, Admin. updates) Exhibit C: Marty Sanchez Links de Santa Fe Golf Financial Summary (Committee members followed as Jennifer verbally read the figures)

Closing the fiscal year and waiting to get word back on those figures. We initially met with the city on our budget, no changes other than one increase for irrigation need. Once this budget closes we will receive our new allocation. Back9 Grill will be receiving a sandwich table and a refrigerator which was on the wish list.

In terms of round we are down 11% but on revenue we are down 8%. (Increases were down in the spring of 2011). Players Pass money comes in and then the rounds are played.

How many rounds should we have by year? In our peak years it was 46,000-48,000 – this year we are lucky if we make 35,000 rounds. We have an increase in tournaments and they are included in rounds. The

delay in the revenue is that in most cases the rounds are played and they pay at the end.

Informational: Received request from the Men's Association to place signage at the turn or by the restaurant as patron's leave the 9 or at the 10. (Wording was read by Vice Chair) – It is important not to put up signs if they are not necessary.

7. <u>Matters from the Committee</u>

Presentation of "Muchas Gracias" Certificate

Vice Chair provided history on the Signe Lindell Muchas Gracias Certificate.

Signe: I love the course, I love the game, and this board has been very good to me. This course is very important to this town. I thank everyone who helped make this course a reality.

Mr. Lopez would like to nominate Manuel from the cart _____. We should give him a gift certificate or get together to provide a gratuity gift for all his hard work.

Mr. Lopez moved and second by John Gabaldon to nominate Manuel for the Muchas Gracias Certificate, motion carried by unanimous voice vote.

Vice Chair called Miguel Gabaldon from DOT and asked for a schematic to show the work they are doing on 599 and how it will affect our area. An invitation has been extended to Mr. Gabaldon to attend one of our meetings. No response to date.

Mr. Gabaldon extended a very nice compliment to the Stenographer and the Committee joined in expressing their thanks for the work and time contributed to the Marty Sanchez Links Advisory Committee. Thank you.

8. Old Business

• Golf Memorial/Tom Cole's Proposal Update

Tom assisted Jen in getting a quote on the rock. Jen said they are working on the language. They are looking at a 6' rock with the wording and 3 rows of the individual's names. Tom provided wording and the committee approved.

Mr. Gabaldon moved to approve the language proposed by Tom, second by Ms. Shaya, motion carried by unanimous voice vote.

A committee was created to include; Fred, Tila, John, Kathleen and Sig to work on the criteria of who would be placed on this memorial/both living and dead. A suggested place for the location would be by the 10. This item can be placed under old business for discussion at the next meeting.

Mr. Lujan joined the meeting and concurred with the report presented by Jennifer under administration. Staff will look in to the revenue / rounds statistics and provide the advisory board with updated information. The Advisory Committee would like for a letter to be prepared and sent to Fabian Chavez for all of his hard work and support through the years and welcome to Ben Gurule who is also a volunteer at the course.

9. <u>Adjournment</u>

Mr. Gabaldon moved to adjourn the meeting at 4:15 pm, second by Ms. Lindell, motion carried by unanimous voice vote.
