- b. Proposed ordinance amending section 23-8.5 SFCC to regulate the types of goods and wares street performers may sell; and amending section 23-8.7 SFCC 1987 regarding criminal enforcement, penalty; and administrative enforcement. (Councilor Bushee, Police Captain Aric Wheeler).

Councilor Bushee would like to see a tighter hold on the sale of these wares and in Section B. it indicates what can be sold. This is the only item changed from a criminal aspect. On page 3, line 7, Administrative Enforcement, this is similar to a business license related to revocation if they are not in adherence with the ordinance.

The question was asked, "what performers are out there?" Captain Wheeler responded; Musical, Individuals with balloon bowers, poets, dancers and others that are considered an art form which is a wide variety.

One example was a vendor selling sage and saying that this was part of his poetry therefore wording in the ordinance would need to be clarified. Trying to cite this person was difficult as he did not have a vendor license.

Ms. Byers added that licenses are issued in accordance with Chapter 18, Article 1 that regulate business licenses and Article 18-8.10 varies the types of licenses and category of business licenses.

Mr. Bowen moved to approve the proposed ordinance amending section 23-8.5 and amending section 23-8.7, second by Mr. Mier, motion carried by unanimous voice vote.

VI. Matters from Municipal Court

Report in packet. Dr. Owen Lewis expressed her thanks for the reports and requested that in the future she would like for there to be live representation from the courts to respond to questions the committee might have.

VII. Matters from Police Chief Raymond Rael (Deputy Chief Johnson)
