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16	WHEREAS, the City of Santa Fe, New Mexico (City), has the legal authority to apply
17	for, receive and administer federal funds; and
18	WHEREAS, the Santa Fe Metropolitan Planning Organization (SFMPO) solicited a call
19	for project proposals through the Federal Fiscal Year (FFY) 2014/2015 Transportation
20	Alternatives Program (TAP), a new federal program authorized under the federal legislation,
21	Moving Ahead for Progress in the 21st Century (MAP-21); and
22	WHEREAS, the City submitted an application for the Santa Fe River Trail/East
23	Alameda Pedestrian Improvements Project (Project), an eligible project under TAP, for
24	pedestrian enhancements such as sidewalk, retaining structures, handrail and necessary
25	appurtenances from El Alamo St. to Canyon Rd : and

WHEREAS, the City was awarded funding for the Project by the New Mexico Department of Transportation (NMDOT), and must adopt a resolution of support for the Project and enter into a cooperative project agreement with NMDOT to receive this funding; and

WHEREAS, the SFMPO Transportation Policy Board approved the project for placement in the FFY 2014-2017 Transportation Improvement Program and is programmed in the NMDOT's Statewide Transportation Improvement Program approved by the New Mexico State Transportation Commission and Federal Highway Administration, for funding in the amount of \$70,000.00 in FFY 2014 for design and \$385,000.00 in FFY 2015 for construction requiring a 14.56% local government match; and

WHEREAS, the City acknowledges availability of the required local matching funds and the ability to pay all upfront costs, since TAP is a cost reimbursement program; and

WHEREAS, the City agrees to maintain the project constructed with TAP funding for the useable life of the project.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF SANTA FE that the City of Santa Fe, New Mexico:

- Supports design and construction of the Project (NMDOT Project Control Number S100281) funded through a cooperative project agreement with NMDOT;
- 2. Accepts responsibility for the project;
- 3. Assumes the lead role for the design development and construction of the project;
- Agrees to the terms, conditions and certification and reporting requirements of the cooperative project agreement; and
- 5. Assumes ownership, liability, maintenance, and related amenities of the Project, and assures the NMDOT that sufficient funding for the local match and for upfront project costs are available.
