10 **A RESOLUTION**

11 **AUTHORIZING THE CONSUMPTION OF ALCOHOL DURING A WINE TASTING**
12 **EVENT PRODUCED BY THE SANTA FE WINE AND CHILE FIESTA, A NON-PROFIT**
13 **ORGANIZATION, ON CITY PROPERTY ON THE LAST SATURDAY OF**
14 **SEPTEMBER, 2020-2024, PURSUANT TO SUBSECTION 23-6.2(B) SFCC 1987.**

16 **WHEREAS**, the Governing Body adopted Ordinance No. 2017-3 on March 8, 2017,
17 which created a new process for approving the consumption of alcohol on city property; and

18 **WHEREAS**, for locations not specifically mentioned in Section 23-6.2(A) SFCC 1987,
19 the Governing Body’s approval of a resolution that specifies the event, date, hours, location,
20 number of expected attendees, type of alcohol to be served, permits, and insurance is required at
21 least thirty days prior to the event; and

22 **WHEREAS**, the Santa Fe Wine and Chile Fiesta is celebrating its 30th anniversary in
23 2020, an event which has become nationally recognized as a premier wine tasting event; and

24 **WHEREAS**, the Santa Fe Wine and Chile Fiesta has become a strong tourism economic
25 generator for the City of Santa Fe with an overall annual impact to Santa Fe in excess of \$5.5

1 million according to a 2018 Southwest Planning and Marketing economic impact analysis; and

2 **WHEREAS**, the Santa Fe Wine and Chile Fiesta’s Board of Directors desires to hold its
3 annual grand tasting on City of Santa Fe property; and

4 **WHEREAS**, Santa Fe Wine and Chile Fiesta will offer complimentary transportation for
5 attendees to and from the grand tasting; and

6 **WHEREAS**, alcohol service for this tasting event will be limited to wine and shall
7 adhere to all regulations required in Section 23-6.3 SFCC 1987; and

8 **WHEREAS**, the Santa Fe Wine and Chile Fiesta requires access to its location several
9 days prior to and after the event to set up and take down all associated equipment due to the size
10 and complexity of the event; and

11 **WHEREAS**, the Santa Fe Wine and Chile Fiesta Board of Directors wishes to host the
12 event on City property for the next five years.

13 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE**
14 **CITY OF SANTA FE** that alcohol service for the following event is hereby approved.
