PROPOSED AMENDMENT(S) TO BILL NO. 2020-14
Temporary Sale of Alcohol on City Property

Members of the City Council:

I propose the following amendment(s) to Bill No. 2020-14:

1. On page 3, line 14 after the closed bracket, *strike* the remainder of the paragraph and *insert* in lieu thereof:

“1. A licensed establishment shall obtain and maintain a general liability policy in the amount of one million dollars (\$1,000,000.00) and a liquor liability policy in the amount of two million dollars (\$2,000,000.00) and must name the city, officers, employees, and agents as additional insureds.

2. The licensed establishment must apply for and receive an obstruction permit from the city that includes the requirement to indemnify the city.

3. The licensed establishment must also obtain a temporary change/expansion of liquor license premises issued by the alcoholic beverage control division of the New Mexico regulation and licensing department. Proof of the approved temporary change/expansion of liquor license premises must be produced upon request of police, fire, or other authorized city official.

4. The sale and consumption of alcoholic beverages on any city property allowed under this subsection shall be subject to the regulations concerning alcoholic beverages contained in SFCC Section 4-2, 1987.

5. Unless extended by ordinance or resolution, any license or permit issued pursuant to this subsection shall expire on October 31, 2020.”
