**Emergency Proclamation V – COVID-19**

**ADDITIONAL EMERGENCY ORDER – November 19, 2020**

**WHEREAS**, on September 28, 2020, I issued Emergency Proclamation V – COVID-19 (Proclamation V), recognizing the extended emergency faced by the City of Santa Fe (City) in the form of the COVID-19 virus (Emergency);

**WHEREAS**, on September 30, 2020, the City’s Governing Body extended Proclamation V through November 30, 2020 by Resolution 2020-39;

**WHEREAS**, I issued a number of orders pursuant to Proclamation V;

**WHEREAS**, since September 30, there has been a surge of COVID-19 cases in Santa Fe;

**WHEREAS**, the State’s most recent Public Health Order ordered all “Outdoor Recreational Facilities” to close, including golf courses, tennis courts, and State Parks; and

**WHEREAS**, residents continue to gather in the City’s parks to use sports courts

and equipment, playgrounds, and other recreational infrastructure, such as skate parks, causing a continued threat of transmission.

**THEREFORE**, due to the circumstances identified above, I am taking the following, additional, temporary actions, effective for the duration of the emergency:

1. All sports courts, including basketball courts, handball courts, and any other courts in the City's parks are closed to the public and may not be used;
2. All playground equipment in City parks is closed to the public and may not be used;
3. All athletic fields in City parks are closed; and
4. All other infrastructure in City parks, including skate parks, is closed to the public and may not be used.

Trails and areas without courts, equipment, or infrastructure remain open to the public with the existing limitations on mass gatherings. Pursuant to Section 20-1 SFCC 1987, any person who fails to comply with Orders issued pursuant to the Emergency Declaration Ordinance, Section 20-1 SFCC 1987, is guilty of a petty misdemeanor.
