

“Commodities” means this site distributes US Dept. of Agriculture TEFAP (The Emergency Feeding Assistance Program) foods. Commodities are county and income based. Clients receiving food will need to provide name and address and certify income is within guidelines. Client should be residents of the county in which they seek commodities.

Commodity Household Size / Annual Income

- 1 person = Less than \$23, 606 per year
- 2 people = Less than \$31,894 per year
- 3 people = Less than \$40,182 per year
- 4 people = Less than \$48,470 per year
- 5 people = Less than \$56,758 per year

For each add'l family member, add \$8, 288 to determine eligibility
