RELEASE OF LIABILITY AND OWNER'S CONSENT TO CLEAN GRAFFITI

In order to clean private property that has been vandalized by graffiti, the City of Santa Fe must have a completed owner consent and release of liability form.

Further, I hereby agree to indemnify, hold harmless, and defend the City, the City Manager, each member thereof, and every supervisor and employee of the City from any and all liability, damages (whether in contract or tort, including personal injury, death or at anytime property damage) cost and financial loss, including all cost and expenses of litigation or arbitration, that result or are claimed to have resulted directly from my wrongful or negligent acts or omissions or those of my agents. Employees or subcontractors while the City is removing graffiti from my property, except in cases of negligence or willful misconduct on the part of the City, City Employee, Volunteers, or Subcontractors.

We will make every effort to remove graffiti as quickly as possible based on personnel, supplies, equipment, and weather conditions.
