



- Scientific sample of 3,000 households
 - 629 returned mail surveys; 23% response rate
 - ±4% margin of error

2017 National Benchmark Comparisons




2017 Custom Benchmark Comparisons – Regional Peer Communities












Importance of Strategic Planning Areas



Support for Gross Receipts Tax Increases




Support for Property Tax Increases




Support for Gasoline Tax Increase


