WELCOMING 2021

When we began working on the 2020 Residential Services calendar in late 2019, we could not have imagined the ways the world would change over the course of the year. The COVID-19 global pandemic fundamentally altered many of our activities, not just here in Santa Fe, but around the world.

In what feels like an instant, we went from business as usual, to seeing “social distancing” and “mask up” become common terms. We navigated the bittersweet necessity of canceling gatherings and celebrations for the collective health of our community, and we learned to communicate with each other through a computer screen just as if we were in a room together. As the days went by and the weeks turned into months, we made many sacrifices to protect our family and friends; and to protect our essential workers, who literally keep our community going. The first (and last) step in our recycling journey begins at the store, with the items you choose from the shelves and take to your home. Choose items with packaging that is accepted in Santa Fe's recycling program; and look for items that are made from recycled material to complete the cycle.

Recycling Options in Santa Fe

THE CITY OPERATES BOTH A CURBSIDE RECYCLING COLLECTION PROGRAM, AND DROP-OFF SITES FOR GLASS (AND ALL OTHER MATERIALS THAT ARE ACCEPTED CURBSIDE).



The Recycle Coach app is free to residents, and is full of information about recycling in Santa Fe!



Once you've emptied that bottle, opened that package, or cleaned out that jar, the next step is placing the item into a recycling container. Be sure it's empty, dry, or flattened.

Did you know? Single-stream recycling (where you have one cart for everything) was first introduced in the U.S. in 1992!

Dumping yard clippings and household waste into arroyos is against the law; not only does it lead to flooding and costly infrastructure damage, but it can harm our water quality too. Take advantage of the Green Waste FREE Days at BuRRT in March, April, May and June to recycle your yard trimmings instead (p. 5).					

A DAY IN THE LIFE:

Alex arrives at the ESD offices on Siler Road at 7:30 AM.

After clocking in, he grabs a phone programmed with RUBICONSMARTCITY™ technology (see pg. 16) and uses the app to complete a pre-trip inspection of the truck, making sure everything is safe for the road!

Once the truck is cleared, he'll open the day's route in the Rubicon app, climb into the driver's seat, and head to his first stop.

Throughout the day, he'll pick up the recycling from approximately 1,000 houses. When the truck gets full – twice a day – he'll stop by the transfer station on Buckman Road to unload.

At the end of the day, he'll head back to the Siler yard. There, he'll wash the truck, complete a post-trip inspection, plug the truck in for refueling at the CNG station* and clock out!

Inside the Recycling Truck

(1) The driver controls an automated arm that extends from the side of the truck, and uses a claw to grab the recycling cart.

(2) The cart is lifted and the contents are dumped into a storage compartment called the hopper.

(3) The recyclable material falls into the hopper and is periodically compacted to allow the truck to hold more material.



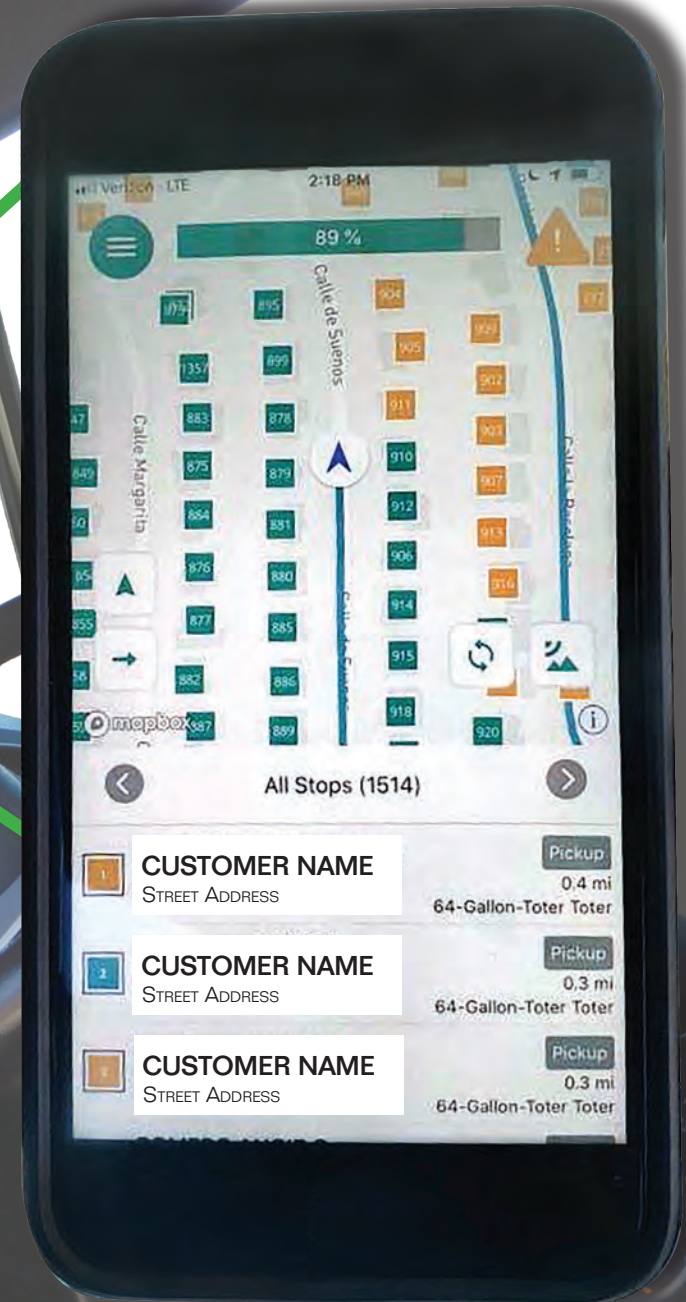

Rubicon: Smart Technology, Smarter Recycling



RUBICONS^{SMARTCITY}TM IS A TECHNOLOGY SUITE THAT HELPS SANTA FE RUN MORE EFFICIENT, EFFECTIVE, AND SUSTAINABLE COLLECTIONS OPERATIONS!

OPERATORS

Operators use Rubicon to navigate routes and track collections. They can take pictures to show blocked carts, carts not out, and contaminated recycling.




SUPERVISORS

Supervisors can track truck progress on routes in real time, and access safety information like speeding, hard stops, and engine status.

CUSTOMER SERVICE

The customer service team can access information uploaded by drivers to aid complaint resolution and enter/track work orders for residents.

Close Up: All About Glass

DOES THE CITY RECYCLE GLASS?

Yes, the City recycles glass! Glass is accepted at all City drop-off locations, and at the Buckman Road Recycling and Transfer Station.

WHERE DOES THE GLASS GO FOR RECYCLING?

The glass collected at the drop-offs in Santa Fe is shipped to Momentum Recycling, a glass recycling plant in Colorado. Visit their website (colorado.momentumrecycling.com) to learn more.

WHY CAN'T I PUT GLASS INTO MY RECYCLING CART?

Single-stream recycling – where all the items are mixed together in one cart and collected by an automated truck – increases recycling rates and is much safer than the old hand-collection system. When the City made this switch in 2017, curbside glass collection was no longer physically possible or economically viable because the City's MRF does not have the equipment to sort glass from the other materials in the carts.

HOW DO I PREPARE GLASS FOR RECYCLING?

Glass taken to a drop-off location should be emptied of any food/liquid. Remove plastic and metal caps; wrappers and labels can be left on.

WHAT IF I CAN'T TRANSPORT MY GLASS TO A DROP-OFF LOCATION?

If you can't make it to a drop-off site to recycle your glass, it's okay to place it in your green trash cart.

Glass and metal can be recycled infinitely – the material doesn't degrade during the recycling process!

First, the recycling truck dumps a load of recycling on the floor of the Materials Recovery Facility (MRF) at 2600 Buckman Road (background image). Then, the recycling is placed on a conveyor belt (1) and travels down the sort line, where workers pick out the items that don't belong (2). After the recycling travels down the line, paper, plastics, and metal are mechanically sorted for baling (3) and shipping to the manufacturer!

Close Up: The Problem of Contamination

Contamination, like plastic bags, food, clothing/textiles, and wires, ropes or hoses (tanglers), is a big problem for a recycling operation. These items get caught in the equipment at the MRF and cause damage that requires expensive repairs.

ABOVE: A PIECE OF MACHINERY AT A MRF THAT HAS BEEN ENTANGLED IN PLASTIC BAGS.

BELOW: THE SAME PIECE OF MACHINERY THAT HAS BEEN CLEARED OF TANGLED SO IT CAN RESUME OPERATION.

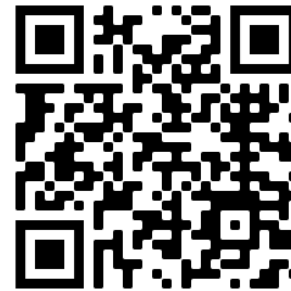

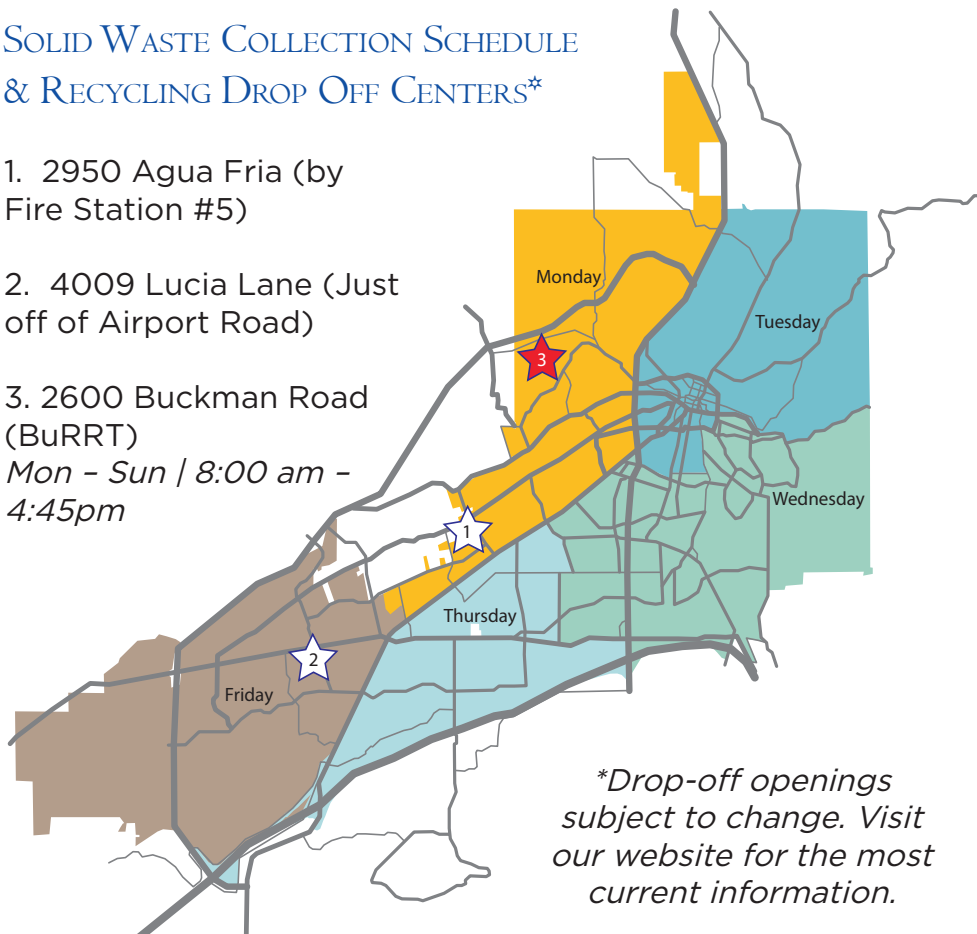
